Springer Open Choice uptake affects 2011 journal pricing

Springer has analyzed the uptake of its open access option Open Choice for articles published in 2009 and is pleased to share its impact on 2011 pricing.

Springer Open Choice allows authors to publish their article with open access in exchange for payment of a fee, for the majority of its journals. The articles are then immediately freely available and the copyright remains with the author, and articles are published under the Creative Commons Attribution Non-Commercial License. These articles can be self-archived with immediate access.

Springer and Helmholtz Association sign agreement for open access membership

Cooperation makes open access publishing easier for scientists

Following the launch of SpringerOpen, the Helmholtz Association has signed a new agreement for an open access membership. This agreement covers article processing charges for authors from the participating Helmholtz research centres for articles published in SpringerOpen and BioMed Central journals.

SpringerOpen journals are peer-reviewed open access journals in emerging and interdisciplinary fields that complement both the established Springer journal portfolios and BioMed Central's growing list of over 200 life science and biomedicine journal titles. SpringerOpen journals are e-only and publish articles under the Creative Commons Attribution license. According to this license, Springer will not reserve any exclusive commercial rights.
