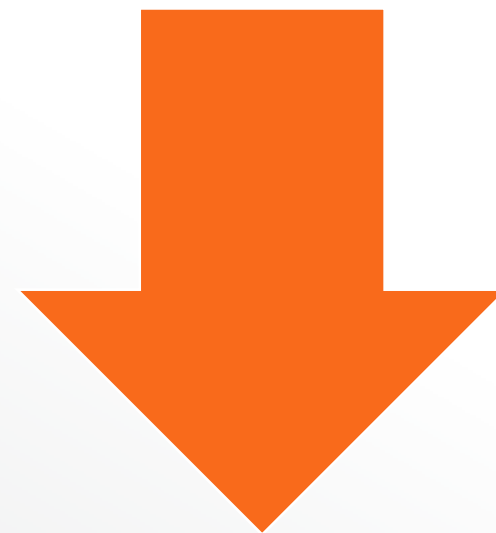

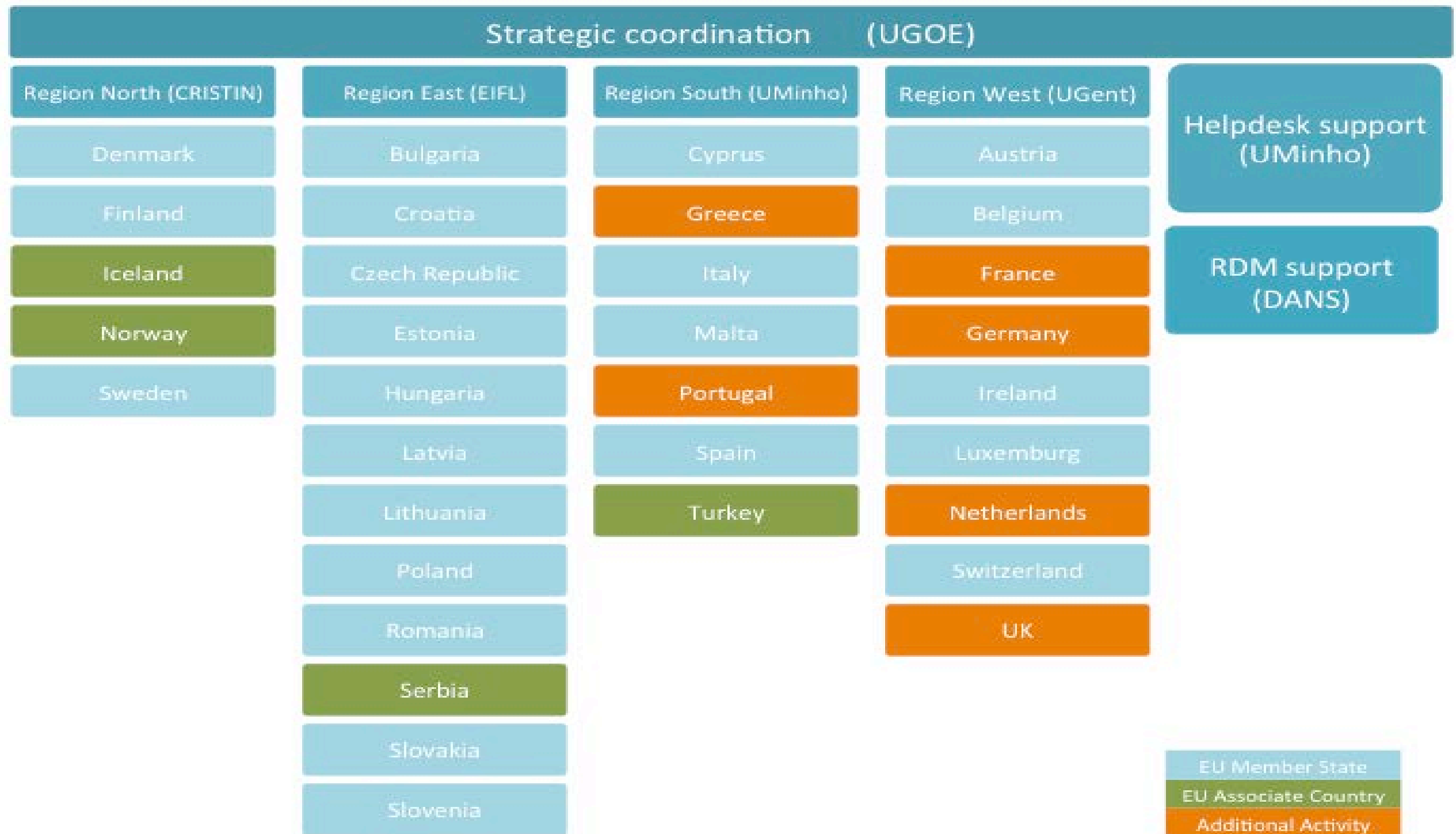

## EC/OpenAIRE FP7 Post-Grant Open Access Pilot

Funding for publications available

Briefing paper for Researchers

### Are you aware?

- Have you have been involved as a **researcher, partner** or a **coordinator** in a recently finished **FP7 project**?
- Are you are involved in an **FP7 project** approaching its end-date?
- Then your forthcoming **peer-reviewed Open Access publications** could be eligible for funding

### Basic Eligibility Criteria

The basic eligibility criteria for collecting this funding are:

- The FP7 project *should have finished* by the time the funding is requested, but *no longer than two years ago*.
- A maximum of **three publications** will be funded per eligible FP7 project as a means to ensure a fair distribution of the funding across projects.
- Funding requests should be submitted *once the manuscript has been accepted for publication*.
- Publications submitted to *hybrid journals* will *not be funded*, but only those which have been accepted at **fully Open Access journals**.
- The following funding caps apply to this funding: **EUR 2,000 for research articles** and **EUR 6,000 for monographs**.
- No page or colour charges will be funded on top of the OA publishing fees.

### Apply for Funding in 5 Steps

**Step 1:** A central service (<http://goldoa-pilot.openaire.eu>) has been made available for collecting and processing direct funding requests from eligible researchers.

**Step 2:** Register with the system to check your FP7 project's eligibility and to submit a request for funding once your manuscript has been accepted for publication in a **fully Open Access journal**.

**Step 3:** The system will request data about both the FP7 project and the accepted publication, including its associated Open Access publishing fees.

**Step 4:** If the eligibility criteria are met, the funding will automatically be granted and the OA Pilot will directly liaise with your publisher for delivering the payment and collecting the invoice. You will be notified of every step in the process via email.

**Step 5:** You will need to invoice **Athena Research Centre** as shown in the example below in order to ensure the OA Pilot accountability. OpenAIRE is working with Open Access publishers in order to streamline the invoicing process.

### Fact sheet for Research Administrators and Project Coordinators

(article processing fees) are eligible for funding.

For subject repository (or Zenodo.org) not enough to list publications via a data management plan (DMP).

European Union (EU) and "Horizon" name of the action, acronym and persistent identifier (e.g. DOI, handle).

12 months for the social sciences and humanities.

### OpenAIRE for Research Managers

### Find or see all of your publications in OpenAIRE at reporting time?

Ensure that they are not deposited in a non-OpenAIRE compliant repository. OpenAIRE portal services (Participate – Research Results) to claim your publications that are either deposited in a repository that is either deposited but not viewable, or not deposited in a repository that can help you out with a few simple steps. In this case you must ensure that the Horizon 2020 rules are followed.

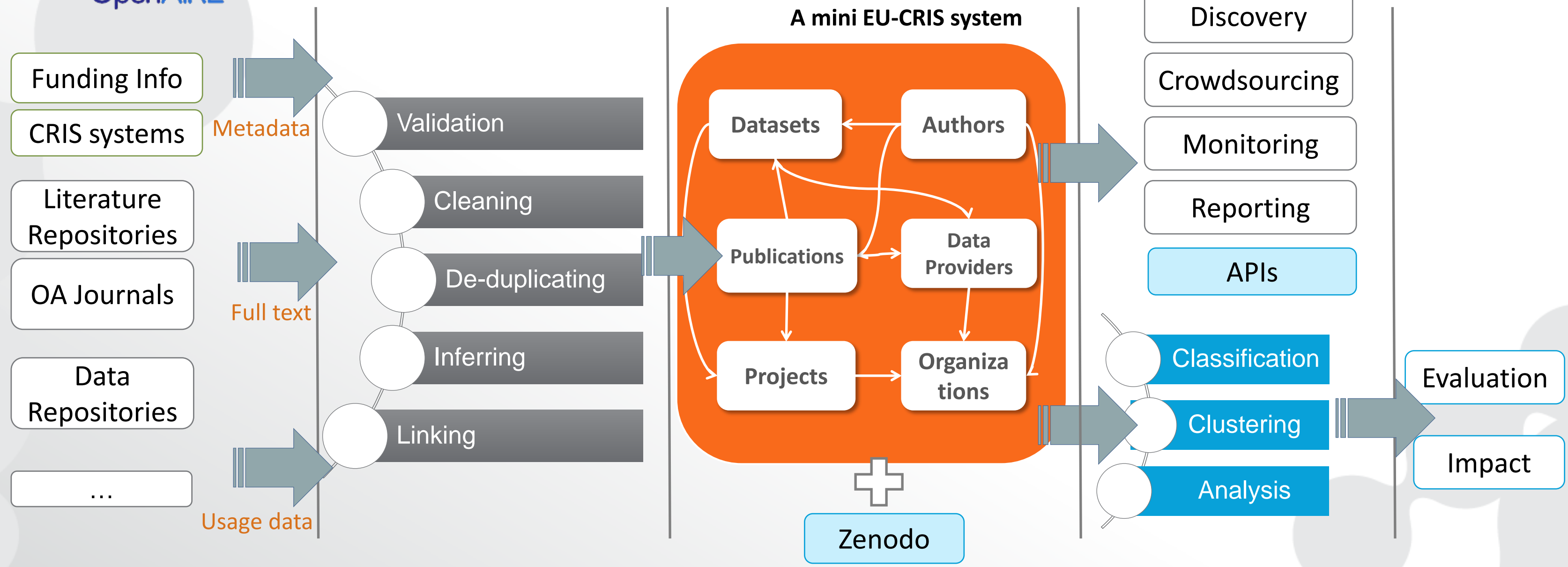

### Could Open Access be provided?

The beneficiary must ensure open access to the publication — via the repository — at (i) on publication, if an electronic version is available for free via the publisher, or (ii) within 12 months of publication (twelve months for publications in the social sciences and humanities) in other cases.

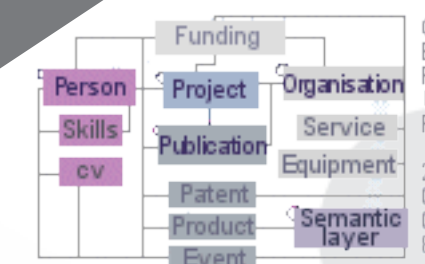
